CODE RED: RALLY TOMORROW!

Tomorrow presents liberty-loving Americans with yet another crucial opportunity to remind our elected officials that the American people reject ObamaCare.

Rallies are taking place across the country, and you are encouraged to activate your networks and spread the word. In the nation's capital, the festivities will begin at 10 a.m. on Capitol Hill at Taft Park where participants will get fired up by a few speakers and then move to the House Office Buildings to lobby their representatives to vote no!

Those unable to get to D.C. can make noise at their local district offices. At 12 noon (local time), join other patriots in driving to your nearest district office and honking your horn for healthcare. Afterwards, go inside and let the staffers know why you oppose this legislation because it violates individual liberty by forcing all Americans to buy health insurance, raises taxes, and funds abortions, among other evils.
