Cut, Cap, and Balance Act (H.R. 2560)

America is fast approaching a fork in the road to its financial future. President Obama wishes to remain on the road that increases government spending, burdens future generations with mountains of debt, and continues the “business as usual” mentality that explains our current financial crisis. The alternative road provides a foundation for a more financially stable environment by following a plan that:

- cuts spending, resulting in an immediate impact on the 2012 budget;
- caps spending, preventing the government from using money it does not have; and
- balances the budget by enacting a Balanced Budget Amendment to the U.S. Constitution.
